TASTING NOTES:

COLOR:

Light pink with a persistant mousse.

NOSE:

Delicate with an elegant bouquet of red fruits and white flowers.

MOUTH:

Beautiful red fruits paired with notes of mineralogy that expand into palette creating the perfect balance in the wine. The finish is refreshing and long with a hint of creaminess.

GRAPE VARIETY:

60% Cinsault, 40% Syrah

POURING ADVICE:

Can brighten up your aperitif and pairs exquisitely with fish, pasta and seafood.
